TAILENDS exists to take in elderly, abused or terminally ill dogs (often – but not exclusively – greyhounds). Our dogs come from situations of abuse or neglect and are unlikely to be rehomed in the normal way.



The greyhounds have normally lived their entire lives in kennels – initially as racing dogs and then kept in bleak conditions out of sight of the general public and with no chance of a home. They have rarely received any veterinary care or pain relief. Some have been fed poor quality food and had infrequent access to clean fresh water. They have sometimes been housed, without coats or proper bedding, in kennels that provide limited protection from the weather.

They commonly suffer from crippling diseases, untreated infections or old injuries.

Tailends provides immediate veterinary treatment, warmth, comfort, loving care, appropriate walks/mental stimulation and good quality food. We can often successfully treat and considerably extend the life of the dog.

There are also tragic occasions when all we can do is to ensure that they receive the best veterinary attention and are comfortable, painfree and loved for their final days in this world.
