Greyhounds make wonderful companions and are often overlooked when people are choosing a dog. They do not need lots of strenuous exercise as many people think. In fact they are real couch potatoes and are happy with just two, twenty-minute walks each day. The rest of the time they are happy to laze around while you do all the work.

They can therefore usually be left for reasonable periods though we do not advise leaving any dog for more than about four hours at a time without someone visiting to give the dog a short walk. Greyhounds are very adaptable and easily fit into a home environment despite often having spent years in kennels. It is our experience that these dogs are very clean and easily become used to a domestic routine. They are so grateful to have some home comforts at last and are very eager to do the right thing and please you.
